SUMMER GARDEN TIPS

USE THIS CHECKLIST TO STAY CAUGHT UP WITH ALL
THE SUMMER GROWTH THAT IS BEGINNING!

- Water plants deeply at the base early morning to encourage strong roots and reduce evaporation.
- Apply fresh organic mulch around plants to retain moisture, suppress weeds, and cool soil temperatures.
- Harvest ripe tomatoes, peppers, and beans regularly to keep plants producing.
- Deadhead spent flowers from annuals and perennials to encourage continued blooming and prevent self-seeding.
- Monitor plants weekly for aphids, spider mites, and other summer pests that thrive in hot weather and damage stressed plants.

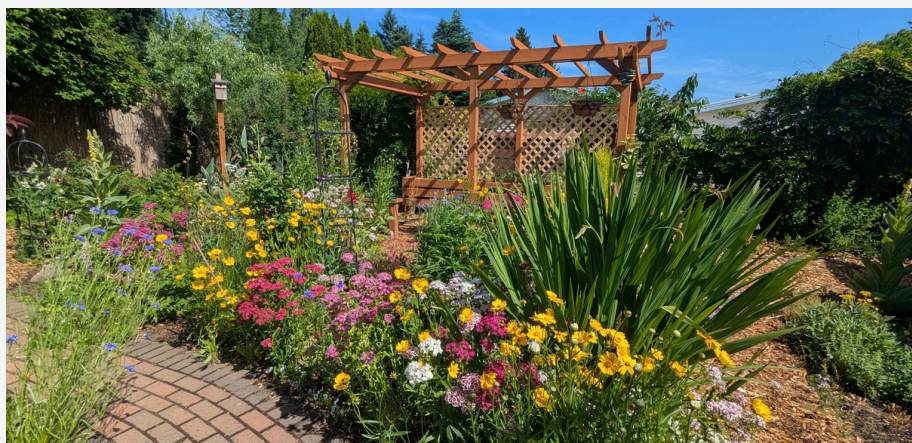

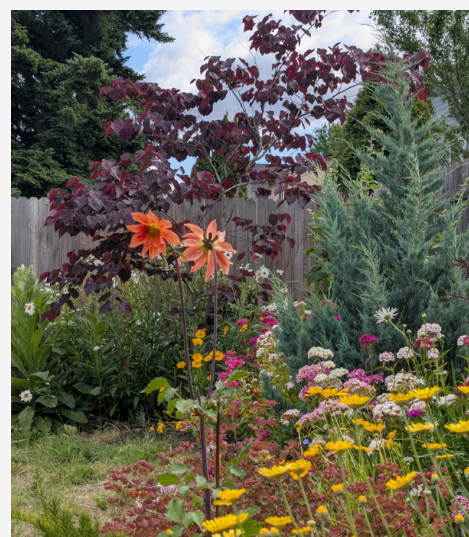


Spring ROOT



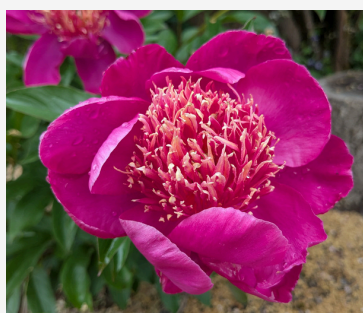
Favorite corner of our garden right now! >
